

Surgical Consent

Your pet is scheduled for anesthesia and/or surgery. Before putting your pet under anesthesia, we will perform a full physical examination. However, we recommend a Complete Blood Count and Chemistry Panel to be performed in order that we may maximize patient safety and alert the doctor to problems. Such problems could be dehydration, diabetes, kidney or liver disease, which could complicate the procedure. In addition, the results of these tests may be useful later to develop faster, more accurate diagnoses and treatments in the event that your pet's health changes.

State of the art equipment enables us to perform these tests within the clinic and we are committed to making this technology available to you. Please check one of the following options for your pet.

- Complete Blood Count and Chemistry Panel.....\$75.00

Note: If other abnormalities are detected on physical exam, more tests may be required.

Due to the anesthetic drugs used and/or the nature of the surgical procedure being performed, your pet may experience a decrease in blood pressure during surgery. Intravenous fluid administration will help maintain a normal blood pressure, replace fluids that may be lost through the procedure, as well as give us easy access to a vein in the event that emergency intervention is needed.

I understand that even with pre-anesthetic blood screening and IV fluid administration there are still potential risks associated with anesthesia and surgery. Risks can include but are not limited to: poor perfusion to vital organs such as the kidney and liver, hemorrhage, post-operative swelling, infection, anaphylactic reaction, and death. I understand that there will not be overnight monitoring of my pet and that if requested my pet may be taken home or transferred to a 24 hour care center.

For spay surgeries please be aware that there will be extra charges if your dog or cat is in heat or pregnant.
